"The ability to better utilise the existing spaces is the most impressive aspect of the Master Plan."

"The Master Plan sets up a complex that can cater for multiple codes on multiple grounds, all capable of being used at once."

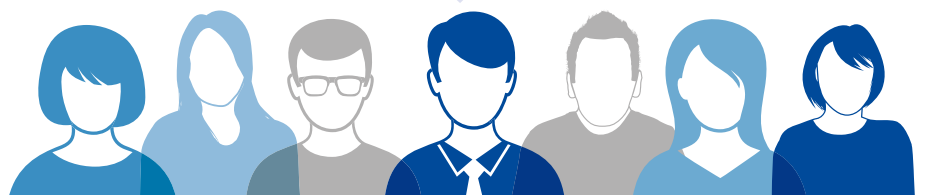
"It has a lot of potential to create a multi-purpose centre for eastern side of Lake Macquarie, even to promote visiting state and international teams."

Things that could be improved:

"Drop-in synthetic cricket pitches would be a highly-beneficial addition to this precinct."

"The concept is great but I think the current draft overlooks the fact that football is the largest sport in the country and we are missing a quality facility in the east Lake Macquarie area."

"There is no provision for batting cages in the proposal. As we have batting cages now, we would propose that they remain in the new plans with the view to extending on the current number that we have."
