Selection of new members

Selection criteria:

- In order to maintain a mix of resident landowners (3-4) and non-resident landowners (4-5), recruit at least one resident and 1 to 2 non-resident landowners.
- 2. In order to include representatives of most paper roads, preference members representing Tulkaba, Karakunba and/or Bushells Ridge Roads.
- Cannot include landowners for whom there may be a conflict of interest due to current or imminent compliance action.
- 4. Include at least one (but no more than 2) owner(s) of multiple lots.
- In order to maintain a mix of ages and gender, include at least two new male.members.
- 6. Mix of longer-term and more recent landowners.
