Thank you to all landowners who attended our drop-in sessions earlier this month. The feedback provided by more than 50 landowners so far has been very important in helping us refine our ideas and indicate your interest in participating in the development of the Wyee West Paper Subdivision.

Key issues

Here's a summary of the feedback Council has received from landowners:

- Participation the majority of landowners are willing to participate in the development of the paper subdivision, however participation is largely dependent on the cost of the infrastructure and how the costs are to be shared. A small number of landowners are not willing or consider they would be unable to contribute towards infrastructure costs.
- Timeframes how long will it take before infrastructure is in place and houses can be built?

- Compliance what is the approach to the structures already there, including where a structure is the landowner's principal place of residence?
- Rates what do landowner's rates go towards?
- Roads will any steps be taken to improve the unformed roads within the paper subdivision in the short-term?
- Rubbish what assistance can be provided to landowners to clean up their land?
