## **ENGAGEMENT SNAPSHOT**



- Increase visibility and representation of culturally and linguistically diverse people throughout the city.
- Increase promotion and awareness of cultural events that encourage community cohesion and showcase diverse cultures.
- Increase opportunities for the community to connect and learn about other cultures.



- Engage with local elders and cultural
- Engage with culturally and linguistically diverse people and organisations.



- Explore diversifying the artists and creatives showcased at exhibitions at our cultural facilities and at community events.
- Explore grant opportunities for initiatives that support culturally and linguistically people.



- Investigate opportunities to highlight culturally and linguistically diverse businesses in the Lake Macquarie area.
- Investigate events for new residents including those from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds to meet other people.



- Support culture-related learning opportunities for children and young people through library programming or school activities.
- Continue to celebrate diversity through events such as Refugee Week, Harmony Day and Living Smart Festival.
- Consider the intersectionality of culturally and linguistically people e.g. LGBTIQA+.
- Ensure promotional materials and communication is simple and on platforms where translation aids can be used.
