


### WE ASKED

- Which park design you prefer
- Which play equipment you prefer

### WE HEARD



84% preferred swing option B

80% preferred balance and agility option A

69% preferred spinning element option A

53% preferred multi-play option B

- Diversity and accessibility in park and playground design are important
- Safety is a priority, with requests for fencing, shade, seating and tables
- Concerns were raised about parking and potential vandalism
- Concerns were raised about the park's location and potential impact on residents

### WE REACHED



**14,302** subscribers via Council e-newsletters



**1,395** engagements via Council's social media



**383** visits to Council's online engagement platform, Shape Lake Mac



**109** online survey responses



**88** people engaged at a community pop-up event

### OUTCOME

Park design option A was chosen because it best accommodated the preferred playground elements. While both designs were similarly favoured overall, the spinning element could only fit in Option A, making it the final choice. Additionally, the multi-play equipment from Option B could not be integrated due to its size and orientation, so option A's multi-play equipment was selected.

### NEXT STEPS

The project will now progress to detailed design, with stage one delivery planned for the first half of 2028.

### FINAL CONCEPT DESIGN

Based on community engagement, preferences and design considerations, the final concept design for Cardiff Town Park is shown below. Additional trees have been added west of the play area to provide long-term natural shade.


