 A diverse mix of housing options is important to meet the needs of all residents

 Communities should be connected, inclusive and welcoming

 Social outcomes matter, with a clear focus on social housing and addressing homelessness

NEXT STEPS

We will use this information along with community feedback from the Lake Macquarie Housing Forum, an independently facilitated housing affordability and liveability survey, the Lake Macquarie City Community Strategic Plan and our Local Strategic Planning Statement to develop our updated Housing Strategy. The strategy is expected to go on public exhibition in the first half of 2026, providing further opportunity for feedback from the community.
