

# WYEE STRUCTURE PLAN DISCUSSION PAPER

## ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY

3 DECEMBER 2025 - 14 JANUARY 2026

Council is making a new Wyee Structure Plan to guide growth and change in Wyee over the next 20 years. The discussion paper is the first step in creating that plan.

### WE ASKED

We asked the community to review the discussion paper and share their feedback through an online survey. Respondents were also asked about their connection to Wyee, with most indicating they live, work, visit or attend school in the area.

### WE REACHED

 **3,329** subscribers via our Shape Lake Mac e-newsletter

 **342** engagements via Council's social media

 **458** visits to Council's online engagement platform, Shape Lake Mac

 **60** online survey responses



### WE HEARD

Sixty people provided feedback. The most common themes of feedback were:

 **Roads, traffic and safety** – calls for investment from all levels of government in this infrastructure

 **Wyee Paper Subdivision** – need to continue to advocate towards provision of services

 **Footpaths, walkability and cycling** – calls to improve this infrastructure and provide continuous footpaths linking Radcliffe Estate, school, shops and train station

 **Economic development and local shops** – desire for a more vibrant centre and local employment

 **Housing density and character** – preference for low-rise options and retention of rural character, support for medium density in certain precincts

 **Health services** – calls for Council to advocate for increased provision of doctors and medical services

### NEXT STEPS
