Council is upgrading and expanding Wye Community Hall Reserve to better serve the growing community in our city's southwest. As part of this upgrade to a district-level park, the playground and skate park will be replaced and newly acquired land next to the reserve will support the expansion.

WE HEARD



The reserve is centrally located and highly valued. It is considered to have strong potential to become a key gathering place as Wye grows



The lack of **footpaths and crossings**—particularly along Hue Hue Road from Radcliffe Estate are a barrier to access



The park is unappealing, and the playground lacks play value for both younger and older children



Concerns about vandalism, poor lighting, antisocial behaviour and general maintenance



Support for **upgraded recreation facilities**, including skate park, multi-sport half courts, pump track and playground for children and young people



Interest by young people in playful areas to socialise and chillout and opportunities for roller skating



The open grassed area and bushland are highly valued. Interest in connecting with the natural area and creek, including walk and cycling paths and signage highlighting flora, fauna and site history



Need for **more shade**, comfortable seating, picnic spaces and areas to rest or gather



Need for **upgraded facilities** including the BBQ shelter, public toilets and car park



Some interest in a **fenced dog area**
