Engagement summary

During November 2016, we asked you to tell us your ideas for a new-look Warner Park. Your input will help us prepare a draft Concept Design for this popular park and playground.

Who participated?

We heard from a broad range of park users including families, grandparents, parental groups, kids and casual visitors.



How you participated

- 752 visitors to Have Your Say webpage
- 160 comments and likes via social media
- 115 people online survey
- 40 people park pop-up session
- 23 online stories (online stories tool)



What we heard

Safe and secure place to play

The main reason people visit the park is for the fenced play area. People would like to see the park fully fenced

Close to cafes and foreshore

People value the park's central location, lake views, trees and grassed area for picnics.

More shade and seating

More shade, shelters and picnic tables would make the park more usable.

Amenity upgrades

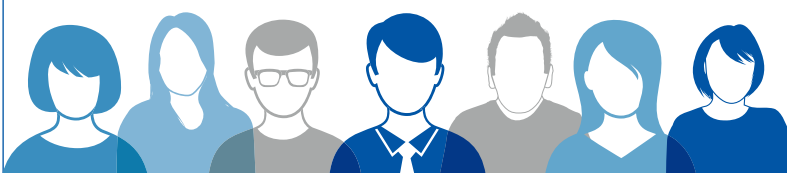
The toilets need improving to better cater for young families and people with disability.

Colour, adventure and obstacles

The playground needs colour, obstacles, climbing frames and natural features.

Soft under foot

The playground needs soft fall or rubber matting and more shade.



Next steps

We are now reviewing all community input to prepare a Concept Design for the park and playground at Warner Park. We expect the draft design will be completed in the first half of 2017.
